PROFILE

I'm a senior full-stack engineer at Siemens Mobility, where I build the .NET and Angular systems behind global rail projects where software where safety requirements and uptime aren't negotiable.

Ten years in, I've worked across enterprise Oracle and C# integration in Brazil, IoT and embedded platforms in Australia, and a stint running my own software studio that taught me as much about scoping and pricing work as about shipping it.

I also taught the Diploma of IT part-time, publish on YouTube, and build developer tools on weekends. I'm most useful on teams solving hard backend problems that still have to feel simple to the people using them.

Deliver cross-stack changes across Angular 18, TypeScript, API workflows, auth/RBAC and deployment configuration for an enterprise microservices platform spanning multiple client environments.

- Build back-end services with .NET Core and EF Core behind modular, high-performance APIs, and ship Angular 18 and Material UI dashboards that turn rail operations data into workflows operators can act on.
- Harden OAuth 2.0, Keycloak and Open Policy Agent authorization paths, reducing auth regression risk and making RBAC behaviour easier to validate across distributed services.
- Improve release confidence for 15+ Docker Swarm services by tightening health checks, deployment validation, service configuration and acceptance criteria before multi-client releases.
- Hold the line on unit and integration coverage to meet Siemens Mobility rail safety standards, partnering with cross-functional teams to shape features around operational requirements.

- Ran complex MongoDB queries and data migrations, working with business analysts to align features with business needs.

- Created a Python automation framework with Selenium and OCR that reduced manual video analysis from 6 hours to 1.2 hours per batch.
